

Rules Summary

Cost to enter: FREE

The **Kickoff Meeting will be held at 9 a.m. Thursday, August 5, 2021** at Frankfort High School. There will be access to attend virtually as well. **All entry forms to be submitted at this meeting or prior via email (kjones@gardentheater.org)**

Selection of winners will be made at the **Finale screening event on August 7, 2021** beginning at 8:30 p.m. The top three winners will be awarded prizes as follows:

- 1. First place receives \$1000 prize money and 2 VIP passes to the 2021 Frankfort Film Festival
- 2. Second and Third places receive cash awards

The top three winning entries will be screened at the 2021 Frankfort Film Festival. Winners will be posted online at Frankfort48.com after the Finale Screening event. All judging decisions are final and binding and will be based on the Judging Criteria. Film making (including all creative work, writing, footage shooting, editing, etc.) must take place between 8/5/21 (9 a.m.) and 8/7/21 (8:59 a.m.) Film crews, cast, film making equipment, location scouting may take place prior to the above-mentioned window of time.

All completed films must be submitted via Vimeo by, August 7, 2021 at 9 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

Vimeo instructions:

- 1. Sign up for a free Vimeo account here: https://vimeo.com
- 2. Make sure your video adheres to all upload guidelines: https://help.vimeo.com/hc/en-us/articles/229838988-preparing-to-upload
- 3. Select your finished film and upload here: https://vimeo.com/upload
- 4. Make sure 'privacy' is set to "anyone can view".
- 5. Upload your video.
- 6. When upload is finished (and the video has successfully processed), send us the link at: KJones@gardentheater.org



Keep in mind that there is a weekly upload limit for all free accounts. If your film file is too large, you will have to compress it or re-export in a smaller format.

If you attempt too many times and reach your upload limit, you may have to use a different email and create a new free account.

Required inclusion elements must be in the exact form specified in the Participant's Packet received at the kickoff meeting.

All cast and crew must be volunteers. Safety of all crew and other individuals (including any non-humans) is very important. Any actions that result in injury or death of any crew or other individual (human or non-human) may result in disqualification at the discretion of Frankfort48.

Any type of equipment may be used.

Any music or copyrighted material of any nature used in a production must have permission for use by the author, including pre-recorded sound effects. Any song parody must also have permission for use by the author. This permission must extend to the Participant, Traverse Traveler and Frankfort 48 for future advertising or promotional purposes.

The films will be no shorter than 3 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes. Before the completed film begins, it must contain the following:

- -five seconds of black
- -a title card with the team name, title, genre, city and date of film
- -two seconds of black

Any opening credits will count against the time limit of the film.

End credits are limited to 60 seconds additional to the length of the film).

Submission is required to be made via Vimeo to frankfort48.com @gmail.com.

All films received on-time will be shown at the public screening. Any late entries received may be included in the screening at the discretion of Frankfort 48, and may be ineligible for any awards.

Releases for talent, crew, music and locations (and any others required) must be submitted with the application packet.

To be eligible for participation in Frankfort 48, the following must be included/adhered to: -original work



- for publication
- -no pornographic or obscene content
- -may not contain any defamatory statements about any person, company, organization or entity
- -may not invade the privacy or other rights of any person, company, organization or entity
- -may not violate applicable laws and regulations
- -any original material copyrighted by the Participant may be used by Frankfort 48

Any film determined by Frankfort 48, in its sole discretion, to include any inappropriate content will be disqualified.

No film may be pre-screened prior to screening at the Garden Theater 7:30 pm on 8/7/21. All rules must be followed to be qualified for the contest.

No entries will be returned.

Frankfort 48 reserves the right to disqualify any entries which are, in its sole discretion, deemed inappropriate or not complete.

Winners will be announced at the completion of the screening at The Garden Theater on 8/7/2021

COMPETITION RULES DEFINITIONS:

Frankfort 48 – Volunteer committee under the sponsorship of the Garden Theater. **Participant** – Any and all members of the team having signed the entry application. **Entry** – The completed film submitted for participants in Frankfort 48. **Contest** – Refers to Frankfort 48 Film Contest.

All teams must have a Participant attend the Kickoff Meeting at Frankfort High School 9 a.m. Thursday, August 5, 2021 either in person or virtually. All entry forms must be submitted at this meeting or prior (online www.frankfortgardentheater.com, regular mail c/o The Garden Theater P.O. Box 341, Frankfort, MI 49635)

Film making (including all creative work, writing, footage shooting, editing, etc.) must take place between 8/5/21 (9 a.m.) and 8/7/21 (8:59 a.m.) Film crews, cast, film making equipment, location scouting may take place prior to the above-mentioned window of time. All completed films must be submitted via Vimeo by Saturday, August 7, 2021 at 9 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE. Evidence of timely receipt will be the timestamp of the email received by kjones@gardentheater.org.

Required inclusion elements must be in the exact form specified in the Participant's Packet received at the Kickoff Meeting.

All cast and crew must be volunteers. Safety of all crew and other individuals (including any non-humans) is very important. Any actions that result in injury or death of any crew or other individual (human or non-human) may result in disqualification at the discretion of Frankfort 48. Any type of equipment can be used.

Any music or copyrighted material of any nature used in a production must have permission for use by the author, including pre-recorded sound effects. Submission via Vimeo to Frankfort 48 is required.
